

Site investigations – Test excavations

As part of the Blackwattle Bay urban renewal, site investigations will occur in the Blackwattle Bay area to assess the existing environment.

What are the site investigations?

Archaeological test excavations will occur to facilitate the early identification of Aboriginal archaeological deposits. This will help plan for the wider urban renewal and Bank Street Park construction.

Text excavations generally involve:

- Establishing 5 small test sites and installing construction fencing around the perimeter of each test site.
- Using power tools, small machinery and hand tools to complete the excavation and digs.
- Reinstating the area at the completion of work.

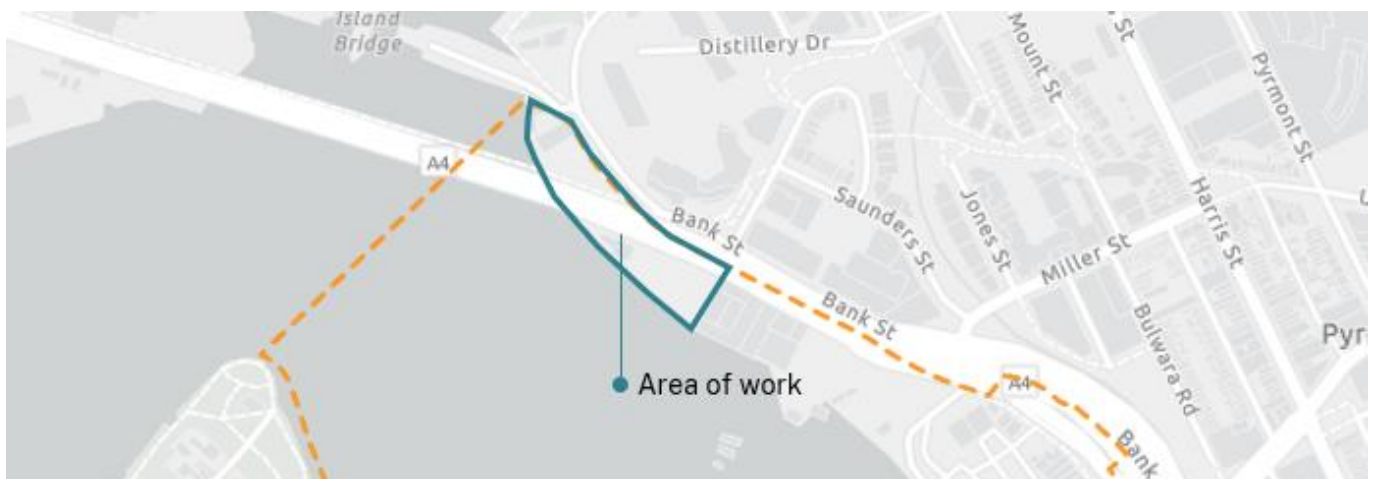

What to be aware of?

- Noise can be expected during the working hours as a result of construction activities. Noisy works, such as saw cutting, will occur intermittently and only occur between 9am and 5pm.
- Majority of the work will occur within the site of 1-3 Bank Street and 5-19 Bank Street. Pedestrian access along Bank Street will continue, with infrequent disruptions as construction vehicles enter and exit the site.
- Mitigation measures will be in place to minimise impacts on the surrounding community.
